## ORIGINAL SONATINA/ SONATA CATEGORY

- 1. Submission must be original work and should consist of at least two movements.
- 2. Movement One should be written using Sonata-Allegro form.
- 3. This is a non-competitive category.
- 4. Participants will receive written comments from judges.
- 5. The judges, at their discretion, may award Honorable Mention(s) for outstanding work.
- 6. The judges, at their discretion, may ask Honorable Mention recipient(s) to perform on Honors Concert.
- 7. The Entry Fee for **Original Sonatina Category** is \$15.

## **SONATAS IN PROGRESS CATEGORY**

- 1. Students will perform one or two movements of a Sonata.
- Sonatas must be selected from Levels 4-8.
- 3. All performed movements should be memorized.
- 4. This is a non-competitive category.
- 5. Participants will receive written comments from the judges.
- 6. The judges, at their discretion, may award Honorable Mention(s) for outstanding work.
- 7. The judges, at their discretion, may ask Honorable Mention recipient(s) to perform on the Honors Concert.
- 8. Students may use **Sonata In Progress** movements as part of complete sonata performances in subsequent festival competitions.
- 7. The fee for **SONATAS IN PROGRESS CATEGORY** is \$25.
